### **THE COINS OF MIESZKO III THE OLD AND SOME UNIDENTIFIED DUKES [OF KUYAVIA?] IN THE HOARD OF ANUSIN**

The study is a presentation of the results of the research on the coins of Duke Mieszko III the Old, as well as of some unidentified (Kuyavian?) dukes, found in the hoard of Anusin, the major part of which is now in the collection of the Hutten- -Czapski Museum. The basis for this research has been composed of the numismatic collection of Zygmunt Zakrzewski, his *Diary*, as well as a number of other works where he provides the information relating to his collections. The author also draws on the publications of Marian Gumowski concerning the hoard of Anusin and the coins with Hebrew inscriptions. These results are given in the form of a table stating the presumable amounts of the coins of each type as represented in the hoard of Anusin, including comments referring to how the particular quantities of items for each type are explained. The numbers of the items from the collection of Zakrzewski (designated Z) are complemented with the coins from the Kuyavian collections recorded by Gumowski (designated K). The analyses have made it possible to obtain a more precise picture of the hoard of Anusin and thus a more complete basis for the exploration of the Polish coinage at the turn of the 12th and 13th centuries.
