

**“Virtus et splendor. Art in the Italian Life in the 14th-17th Centuries.”
Exhibition of works from the collection of the Princes Czartoryski
Foundation, National Museum in Gdańsk, Green Gate,
31 Dec. 2013 – 30 Mar. 2014**

The exhibition features nearly eighty objects, almost all of them drawn from the collection of the Princes Czartoryski Foundation, rounded out by a few items from the National Museum in Gdańsk. The exhibition space was divided into two principal parts: home and church, with particular artworks assigned to each. The key objective of the exhibition was to show objects by pointing up and, so to say, bringing back their original function and significance. Outstanding for its attractive, carefully thought-out visual design, the exhibition gave an opportunity to glimpse at artworks from the perspectives of their recipients, patrons and users.
